The result was more than 2000 pounds of new toys collected and shipped to Houston, Texas, where they were wrapped and distributed just in time for Christmas to these children who were victims of Katrina's terrible wrath. And what made it even more special? Through the generosity of local support, KJ was able to fly to Texas and personally help in the distribution of the toys to these very special children. At the same time, he also received an award from Somebody Cares America as a Champion of Compassion.
